Submitting a Recording

Recorded auditions are due 10 days before the live audition and must be submitted along with a signed copy of the declaration below to auditionapplications@sydneysymphony.com.

Recording Guidelines

- Applications without video will not be accepted
- Full audition must be recorded in one single take, unedited and uncut
- The material must be recorded in the following order:
 - o Set repertoire
 - Own choice concerto (if requested)
 - Orchestral excerpts (in the order listed)
- It is preferred that concertos are accompanied
- Submissions must clearly identify the start time of each movement of the concerti and individual excerpts, as well as the name of the work and the composer.
- Accepted formats:
 - o mp4, avi, mkv etc transferred by dropbox, mail, wetransfer etc
 - o url to third party hosting site (eg Vimeo for best quality)
