The Sydney Symphony Orchestra (SSO) has today announced the appointment of Karen Moses as a Director to the Board of the Orchestra. Ms Moses is currently Executive Director, Finance and Strategy at Origin Energy Limited, where she has had an outstanding career of more than 20 years. She will be retiring from her roles at Origin to pursue a career as an independent non-executive director.

Upon announcing the appointment, SSO Chairman Terrey Arcus said: “Ms Moses brings great strengths to complement the board of the SSO. As a public company CFO she has a deep understanding of finance and accounting and as the head of strategy of various major long cycle companies, she will be able to contribute well to long term strategic thinking about the orchestra’s ambitious aspirations. I am delighted she has agreed to join the SSO Board.”

With a national and international career spanning three decades in the energy industry, Ms Moses has worked across the sector in oil, gas, electricity and coal commodities, and upstream production, supply and downstream marketing operations.

Ms Moses is also a director of Australia Pacific LNG Pty Limited, SAS Trustee Corporation, Sydney Dance Company and Boral Limited from March 2016. She holds a Bachelor of Economics and a Diploma of Education from the University of Sydney.
